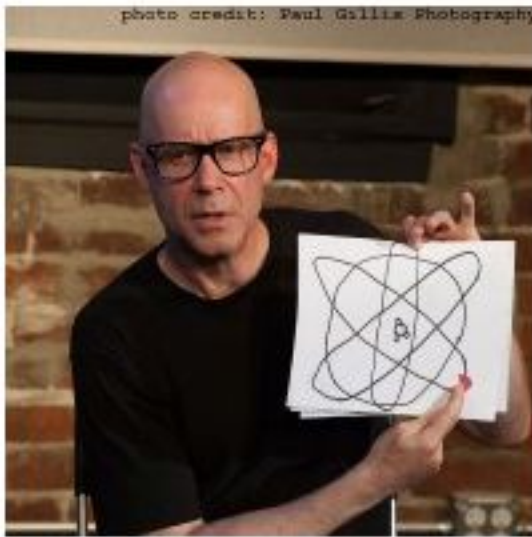

The plight of the single dude is well-trod territory for a fringe performer, but Boston humorist Randy Ross has the writing and acting chops to make it work. In a one-hour, one-man show, Ross recounts the lowlights and even lower lights of a round-the-world trip to find himself and possibly a mate after getting laid off and getting out of a series of failed relationships.

Ross's travelogue takes him from his therapist's couch to a ferry off the coast of Greece, a bar in South Africa and a sketchy Phnom Penh parking lot. In every location, disappointment awaits. Ross's honesty makes the self-deprecating voyage of sometimes-lurid discovery a lot of fun to watch. Warning: May not be suitable for middle-aged men who remain children.
